Groups: Beginner and Pre – Intermediate groups.

Theme: "Kazakhstan- is my motherland"

The aim of the lesson:

1) Educational: to train new words and discussion an English language

2) Developing: To develop the listener's habits of the oral speech, to develop listener's creative and logical abilities, understanding, reading and writing, grammar and lexical skills.

3) Bringing-up: to educate of the culture of communication, the ability to listen to the interlocutor, cooperate and help with working in a group or a couple. language bring up love and interest to the subject, to respect each other, to create an English atmosphere in the classroom.

Types of the lesson: an open lesson.

Methods: reading, writing, listening, speaking.

Lesson plan form

1. Organization moment: (3 minutes)

Teacher: Our lesson Kazakhstan was established as the Republic of Kazakhstan in December 1991. The country is the second largest of the former Soviet republics with a total land area of over two million seven hundred and twenty four thousand nine hundred million square kilometres. This country shares its border with the Russian Federation to the north and north-west; the with China and to the south with the central Asian republics of Kirgyzstan Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan. The Ural River flows through the western portion of Kazakhstan to the Caspian Sea. The central region of the country includes the Kazakh Steppe to the north and deserts of central Asia in the south-west. The Altai moun- tains can be found in the east The country is rich with mineral resources such as copper, gold, iron. lead, nickel, silver, tin, uranium and zink with deposits of oil and natural gas. The largest city of Kazakhstan is Almaty which lies to the south-east of the country near the border with Kirgyzstan and China. Almaty was the capi December 1997 then it was moved to Akmola, eight hundred fifty kilometres to the north-west. In May 1998 Akmola was renamed Astana was Nur- Sultan , the Kazakh word for capital. The population of Nur- Sultan stands currently at five hundred thousand .

Peaceful and generous, the land of the Kazakhs has always been famous for its hospitality. And it is not by accident, located on the crossroads of two ancient cultures -Europe and Asia. Today residents are happy to share that famous hospitality and to show the visitors the Alatau mountains with famous Medeu: the singing sands of the Altyn Emel National Park: Kapchagai reservoir on the Ili river, the lakes and pine forests of Kokshetau; and Akhmed Yissaui Mausoleum in Turkestan, a lot of places of interest in Nur- Sultan. Kazakhstan. with the world's ninth largest area, has many such beautiful places and a rich culture

The official language is Kazakh and Russian is the language of international communication.

V. It is not a secret that every nation and every country has its own customs and traditions. Holidays, traditions and customs in Kazakhstan. Who knows what holidays there are? *Kazakhstan Nations Unity Holiday day - 1 May:*

L7: *Kazakhstan Nations Unity Holiday / Labour day - 1 May:*

This day was celebrated as a holiday of workers’ solidarity in the Soviet time. Today this is a holiday of unity of all peoples who live in the territory of Kazakhstan. This bright spring holiday is held in every city of Kazakhstan with parades and processions along the central streets of the cities and also with entertaining events

L8: *International Women's day - 8 March:*

March 8 - the International Women's Day - is a very popular holiday in Kazakhstan. And it is a must for every gentleman in the county to congratulate the ladies. Kazakh women also receive flowers and gifts on this day. All men also congratulate their mothers, daughters, grandmothers.

L9: *Nauryz - 22 March:* Nauryz is a very important holiday for Kazakhs, which marks the beginning of a new year. It is celebrated several days starting from 21st of March. Nauryz is an ancient holiday full of symbols! Nauryz kozhe is the traditional spring-time soup of seven components. During the Nauryz holiday, large and small cities, villages become festival centres, yurts – traditional nomad houses are erected in city centres and rich dastarkhan (table).

L10: *Men's Day - Feb 23:*

Previously, Feb 23 was celebrated as the official Soviet Army Day in the Soviet Union. Now it is not famous as Men's day. All Kazakhstan people celebrate this day on 7 th may they usually receive the gifts from women.

L11: *Victory day - 9 May:*

The 9th of May is a special day for all Kazakhstan people. This is Victory Day. This is the day when the Great Patriotic War finished (they call the World War II).

Kazakh people do not forget their heroes. In every city concerts are held in honour of the Great Patriotic War. Grandchildren and great-grandchildren thank veterans for freedom.

L12: *Independence Day - 16 December:*

16 December is the most important day in the events calendar in Kazakhstan. It commemorates independence from Soviet Union through street festivals, parades and fireworks. The day is also a time to remember the victims of the events of December 1986. Kazakhstan Independence Day is marked by festivities in the presidential palace and many Kazakhs will dress up in traditional clothes.

L13: *Kurban ait:*

The end of a month of daytime Ramadan is celebrated by the feast. On this day, big feasts and celebrations are organized by the Muslim people. Every family usually tried to slaughter a sheep for this holiday. As the saying goes in Kazakhstan - “Құрбанайт қабыл болсын!” It is hard to imagine how pleasant it was to ride a horse or go for a walk during this time of year. People would enjoy kokpar a national game in one place; close by one might see zhigits wrestling.

L14: *Symbols of the Republic of Kazakhstan.*

The flag and national sign of every country shows its independence. Thus our country Kazakhstan has its own flag and national sign. In the middle of blue rectangle there is a sun with an eagle, with its wings spread under it those symbols and Kazakh national ornament gosghar mewiz on the left side of them are in the golden yellow colour.
